
How you can help your child:

- Please listen to your child read as regularly as you can and talk about what he/she has read, discussing unfamiliar vocabulary, characters and story plot. This is the area which will most help your child to make progress with their learning.
- Please make sure that children are accessing reading plus at home.
- Practice counting in different numbers. The children are already familiar with counting in 2s, 3's 4's, 5s and 10s, and continuous support of this will help greatly.
- Ensure that your child has the relevant PE/games kits in school. Kit should be in school at all times. PE is on both a Monday and Tuesday, but there may be times where we swap things around.

Information about our theme

This term our school topic is called "Eye Spy". As part of this theme we will looking into life in Ancient Egypt, and documenting out learning using art and the imovie app to make our own news reports. exploring habitats and looking at what humans and plants need to grow. We will be helping to develop the new nature area by building out own wildlife houses and feeders.

Art/Design Technology/Music

We will be:

- experimenting with tones and shades using pencils
- improving our pencil control, focusing on weight on pencil lines
- recreating our own versions of pieces of art Egyptian art including death masks and statues.
- learning how to play music as part of a group.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be learning to:



- learning to use inverse operations to solve addition/subtraction problems.
- ordering and comparing numbers beyond 100
- learning how to count in multiples of 2, 3 and 4, applying our 2s to help learn our 4s.
- building on prior knowledge using bonds to 10 and 20 to find bonds to 100.
- Using multiplication to solve division.
- Problem solving

<u>English</u>

We will be learning to:

- listen and respond appropriately to adults and their peers
- listening to and discussing a wide range of texts, expressing opinions.
- reading texts that are structured in different ways and reading for a range of purposes.
- writing in a wide range of contexts stories, fact sheets, instructions.
- Organising writing through quality, punctuated sentences.
- Improving our vocabulary base.
- Introduce a variety of conjunctions.
- Performance, acting and the importance of tone and projection of voice. Building of confidence and shaking off the shyness.



<u>Science</u>

We will be:

- Developing our scientific enquiry skills.
- Looking at different animals, including humans, looking at what we need to grow and stay healthy.
- Looking at how plants grow and make comparisons to humans.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

R.E/PHSE

We will be learning about character education and how to develop positive virtues. We will be working on building our class as a team, looking at the positive attributes each person brings to the class.

Geography/History

We will be:

- Using maps, atlases and globes to find and compare different parts of Egypt.
- Identify different geographical features on a map.
- Learning about life in Ancient Egypt.
- using timelines to understand chronological order
- Looking at significant discoveries, who discovered what and when and what we have learnt from their discoveries.

Computing

We will be:

- Creating our own news reports using imovie to present our learning about the Egyptians.
- Using the internet for research and continue to learn about internet safety.
